
PIPE SEAL-How to Use

GENERAL INFORMATION:

Oatey Soil Pipe Seal is a permanent caulking lead substitute for sealing cast iron soil pipe joints and cracks. This seal solves problem areas where molten lead (soldering) cannot be used.

APPLICATION:

Pack joint with Oakum in the usual way. Be sure the Oakum is tightly packed and that not too much is used. Pack Oatey Pipe Seal in the joint generously with a putty knife working rapidly to avoid drying. Smooth off the top and allow the seal to set. If the Oatey Pipe Seal becomes too dry, moisten with lacquer thinner.

RESTRICTIONS AND CAUTIONS:

DO NOT USE OATEY PIPE SEAL ON PLASTIC. This product is flammable and can be irritating to skin, eyes, and respiratory system. Please see attached Material Safety Data Sheet.
